

We want your food scraps!

CNLC has a compost hub to take your kitchen scraps. Recycling will reduce waste and help our garden.



- uncooked vegetables scraps
 - fruit scraps
 - coffee grinds and tea bags
 - crushed egg shells
 - shredded newspaper, cardboard and egg cartons
 - hay and straw
 - old potting mix
 - grass clippings
 - cut flowers
- dairy products
 - anything cooked
 - meat, fish or bones
 - oils and fats
 - pet poo and litter
 - breads and cereals
 - glossy paper (magazines)
 - plastic or biodegradable bags
 - garden waste and branches
 - rubber bands and tags

How it works

- Fill your food scrap container (ask CNLC for one if needed)
- Place contents in the bin at CNLC on the corner of Station St. and Princes St. Carlton North
- Our team will use the scraps to make beautiful compost to be used in the CNLC garden
- Let us know if you need any compost or seedlings for your garden!
